Why salons?

In Australia, two women die every 10 days due to family violence. Research shows that many women form close relationships with their salon professionals and confide in them about the violence or controlling behaviour they are experiencing at home. A project of Eastern Domestic Violence Service (EDVOS), HaiR-3Rs is an internationally evidence-informed family violence awareness training for salon professionals to learn how to recognise signs of family violence, respond appropriately to disclosures and refer clients to family violence services for help and support.

What we cover

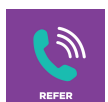
Our three hour interactive workshop is open to anyone working in hair and beauty, including students. Participants will learn:
